The Moravian Society

The Moravian Church was founded in 1457 in Bohemia.

Moravians first came to Britain in the 1730s and set up congregations by invitation of local people often establishing Settlements with their own farms, industries and schools.

Ockbrook, a School established by the Moravian Church in 1799, maintains a Christian ethos which shows itself throughout the life and work of the School. Governors, teachers, pupils and parents work together in the pursuit of excellence.

In addition to Ockbrook School, the Church has one other boarding/day school, Fulneck School which is located in Leeds.
